9. Can I apply for financial support from ENETS?

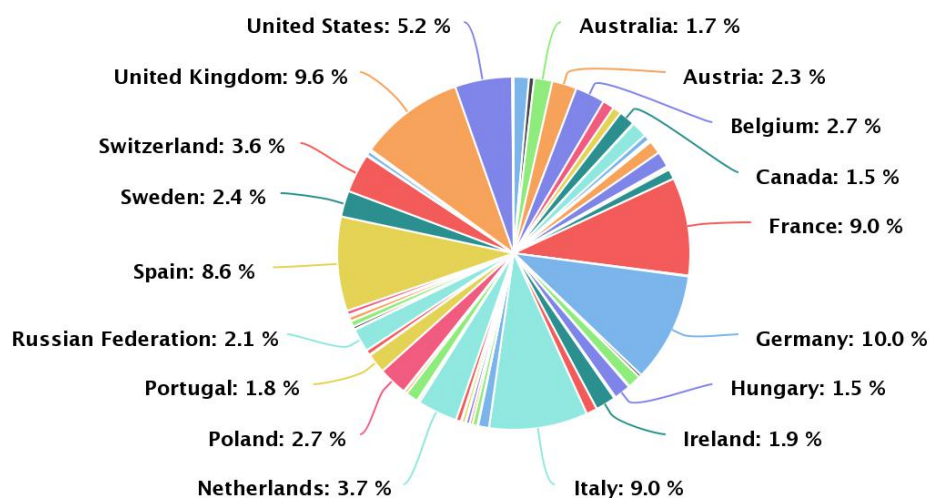
